GUIDELINES:

1. Branson Schools Foundation teacher and school grants are available to instructional staff in the Branson R-IV School District.
2. All funding/grants must propose an innovative and creative project that will enrich and enhance student learning beyond the normal requirements of those offered presently within the school system.
3. Applications will be reviewed and awarded twice per year – fall and spring.
4. All successful grant winners must use the funds within one year from time the grant is awarded.
5. Recipients of the grant will be expected to provide the Foundation with a written report of their project when complete, with details and number of students served.
6. Applications are available on the Branson R-IV Education Foundation website @ www.BransonEducationFoundation.org.
7. Applications for the fall grants are due **March 23, 2018**.
8. Three copies of the grant application should be received by the Foundation by **5:00 PM** on the date due.
9. A committee of the Foundation will review each application and award the grants within a week of due date.

Successful proposals will meet the following criteria:

- Strengthen academics.
- Meaningful and engaging for students.
- Long term benefit for school system.
- Detailed budget.
- Creative and innovative approach to education.

Who may apply:

- Teachers (instructional staff).
- Teams of teachers or individual schools.
- Principals & school administrators.

PROPOSAL

1. State the major objectives for your project. What unmet needs does it address?

2. Describe your project. What will you be able to do that you cannot do now?

3. Explain how your project will enhance teaching and learning for Branson students.

4. How many students will benefit from your project this year and in the future?

5. Briefly describe your budget items and their estimated cost. If possible, include photocopies of equipment and educational materials you hope to purchase. (Keep in mind that BEF grants cannot be used for teacher salaries or stipends, food, decorations or registration fees.)

6. Will you use other resources as part of this project? Please explain. (Other resources could include technology or other materials owned by the building, the expertise of other teachers or community members, funds obtained from other sources, etc.)

7. How will you evaluate the success of this project?
